English

Art

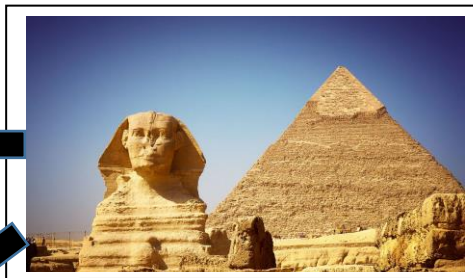
This term we will be exploring plant art, and focusing on artists who focus on leaf and flower art. We will be exploring a range of mediums to capture the colours, detail and texture of plants.

Computing

This term we will continue to look at creating power point presentations with information and we will be sharing them with others.

History/Geography

During the EGYPTIAN we will look at: achievements of the earliest civilizations – Depth of study of Ancient Egypt, Gods, religion, and impact on culture and belief. We will also find out about Historical trade links, distribution of natural sources.

French: We will be learning parts of the body through songs and a short story. Then we look at summertime and holidays particularly looking at beach related vocabulary.

Music: We will be using instruments to improvise and compose using given notes.

Science

This half term our unit of work is called 'Making Connections'. We will revise and build on all the Year 3 learning covered. The children will plan and carry out a scientific enquiry.
