

Maths

We will be learning about decimals, relating our knowledge to dividing a number by 10 and 100 and making links between decimals and fractions. We will also be learning about money, calculating using money and finding change. Finally, we will be solving problems involving time. We are actively encouraging the children to learn their times table facts by heart.

English

We will be reading the following texts and watching the following short films, using them as a basis for writing.

We will be answering VIPERS questions on each text as well as writing in different styles for different audiences.

Summer 1st

Art

We will be developing our skills as painters this term. We will use a variety of mediums to create a piece based on the style of two artists – Claude Monet and Jason Miller.



Computing

We will be learning how to edit photos, and how they can then be resaved and reused. They will consider the impact that editing images can have.

History

We will be learning about the Anglo Saxons as invaders and settlers. We will find out why they wanted to come here, where they came from and what life was like then.

Music/Spanish:

Spanish: Children will have an introduction to the Spanish language.

Music: Children will be learning how music brings us together, further developing their understanding of structures in music.

Science

Our topic this term will be Living Things: Classification and changing habitats. We will be grouping and classifying living things and exploring habitat changes.

RE
