The children will continue to learn their times tables and will be tested weekly. Please continue to practise at home.

The children will be using cubes, base 10 and other manipulatives to explore and compare numbers if required.

English

We will be looking at the following texts during our reading into writing sessions.

The Lion and the Unicorn – a picture book telling the story of a WWII evacuee child.

The Odd and The Frost Giants - a quirky retelling of a Viking myth.

We will be answering VIPERS questions on each text as well as writing in different styles for different audiences.


DT

Computing

We will be exploring how and why we collect data and what we can do with the information collected.

Geography

We will be learning about Mountains. We will explore how they are formed, learn the names of different parts of a mountain and look at the impact on the lives of people who live in and near them.

Music/French
