

English: Reading into Writing

- ◇ In English this half-term, we will finish reading Holes and compare the book to the film. Our writing task will be to write a survival guide to Camp Green Lake
- ◇ We will learn about a Rube Goldberg machine and design and write instructions for our own useless contraption.
- ◇ We will also be writing letters to the Y5 pupils about Y6

Maths

We will be developing our maths skills through real-life, practical scenarios. We will be exploring how maths is used in everyday situations, helping children build confidence and independence as they prepare for the next stage of their education.

Science

Evolution and inheritance

We will be finishing our unit on how living things have changed over time and how fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago. We will identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

Music
