

## Maths

This term we will be focussing the relationship between the 2,4 and 8 times tables. The children will practise the key skills and then given the opportunity to apply these skills to solve problems independently. We will also start the unit on unit fractions.

We will continue to learn and practice times tables to improve confidence and fluency.

## English

This half term we will be reading *The Cloud Tea Monkeys* by Mal Peet and *Elspeth Graham Flotsam* by David Wiesner. We will learn skills to support the children in writing a non-chronological report, a diary entry and narrative based on Flotsam.

We will continue to master our reading comprehension and spelling skills and continue to learn the Year 3/4 spellings.

## DT

We will be focussing on food this term, looking at foods and teas from around the world. The children will also get the opportunity to become tea tasting sommeliers, trying teas from around the world.

The children will also design and make a box for their uniquely designed tea.

## Computing

Learners will explore branching databases by creating both physical and digital versions. They will use yes/no questions to understand attributes and sort objects. The unit concludes with building and testing an identification tool while considering real-world

## Geography

This term in geography we will be looking at our blue planet. We will be looking at the oceans and how they are under threat through pollution and over fishing. We will be looking at ways in which we can protect our blue planet.

## Music/French

French: This term the children will learn the days on the week and the months of the year and learn the different seasons in French. The children will also learn how to say when their birthday is. They will also consolidate counting to 20

Music: This term we will be looking at musical styles like reggae and will be playing and singing songs from other genres too.

## Science

This term our focus is **FORCES & MAGNETS**: Comparing forces on varied surfaces, between objects, magnetic properties.

## RE

The children will explore the significance of Good Friday, reflecting on its meaning in the context of salvation and why it is considered "good."

## PSHE

The children will be learning about their rights and responsibilities and will be looking at how they can keep each other safe too.

## PE

This term we will be learning about different athletic sports and skills. We will also be looking at orienteering and working as a team to solve problems.
