Maths

We will be exploring the perimeter and area of rectilinear shapes.

Children will be looking at decimals, with a focus on tenths and hundredths and understanding the value of these. We will be consolidating the children's understanding of standard written methods.

We are actively encouraging the children to learn their times table facts by heart.

English

We will be looking at the following texts during our reading into writing sessions.

The Lion and the Unicorn – a picture book telling the story of a WWII evacuee child.

The Odd and The Frost Giants - a quirky retelling of a Viking myth.

We will be answering VIPERS questions on each text as well as writing in different styles for different audiences.

<u>DT</u>

We will be combining our work on electricity in Science with our DT skills to design and make an alarm.

Computing

We will be exploring how and why we collect data and what we can do with the information collected.

<u>Geography</u>

We will be learning about Mountains. We will explore how they are formed, learn the names of different parts of a mountain and look at the impact on the lives of people who live in and near them.

Music/French

French: The children will be learning about clothing. The names for different clothes and how to describe what they are wearing, including the colour.

Music: Children will be focussing on learning about dynamics and how to apply their understanding in performances and compositions.

Science

This half term we will be learning about Electricity! We will be exploring static electricity, circuit symbols and will be learning how to build our own circuits.

<u>RE</u>

Our main religion focus this half term is Christianity and forgiveness on the lead up to Easter. We will be paying particular attention to the idea of forgiveness.

PSHE

This term we will be learning how to keep ourselves safe with a focus on rights and responsibilities. We are looking forward to a visit from the Life Van.
