English: Reading into Writing

- ♦ Inspired by the magical creatures in JK Rowling's Fantastic Beasts and Where To Find Them, we will design and create our own fantastic beasts and write a formal field guide entry about them.
- ♦ We will also read an abridged version of *MacBeth* and develop our opinion and debate who is more evil MacBeth or his wife.
- ♦ In Grammar, we will learn how to use the passive voice to add effect to our writing and continue to develop our use of conjunctions to link ideas within and across paragraphs.

Science

Living Things & Their Habitats

We will be learning about classification including microorganisms, plants & animals.



Music

The children are continuing to learn about musical form through a large classical vocal work called Carmina Burana by Karl Orff.

Geograpy: Trade and Economics

- We will be locating the world's countries, using maps, to focus on countries that trade with the UK
- We will identify the position and significance of the Prime/ Greenwich Meridian and time zones (including day and night)
- We will study the human and physical geography of the UK and El Salvador, and understand how they link to trade.

French

The children will learn vocabulary for the subjects learned in school. They will listen and respond to French children telling them their preferred subjects and describe their own preferences. They will learn to give a reason for their opinions using the word for because.

PSHE

We will look at rights and respecting, and how this will support our environment.

Maths

- We will also be revising key skills to support us with our SATs

PE

- Dodgeball: We will be using a range of skills that are required across all sports to refine our knowledge in this invasion game

Computing We will explore how data can be structured in a table. Finally, chilldren will input data into a spreadsheet.
