## English

- **Stories by the same author**-reading and comparing stories by Julia Donaldson. Planning and writing our own version of a story.
- **Classic Poetry** -The Owl and the Pussycat. Reading, learning and performing the poem.
- **Persuasive writing**-reading and comparing examples of persuasive writing. Writing a simple persuasive leaflet.
- **Poems with a structure**-reading and writing riddles.
- **The children will also do daily phonics sessions and will do a guided read once a week.**

## Physical Education

## Science and Creative Curriculum

Our topics for the term are 'The Great Outdoors' and 'Robots'.

### Science

Materials and their properties, changing materials.

### Art and DT

Investigating structures-making strong structures, investigating uses of materials, designing and making bridges.

## Mathematics

- **Addition and subtraction**-adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers, solving addition and subtraction problems.
- **Multiplication and division**-recall facts and use to solve problems.
- **Time**-telling the time to the five minutes. Solving problems involving time.
- **Fractions**-finding fractions of numbers and shapes.
- **Money**-recognising different coins, making amounts using different coins, solving problems involving money.
- **Problem solving and investigations**-using Mathematical knowledge to solve problems.
