English

Units

- Novel on a theme

Writing Write sentences with capital letters and full stops. Read each sentence to check that it makes sense. Use speech marks to punctuate direct speech. Apply their phonic knowledge and spelling rules when writing. Use prepositions: above, below, beneath, within, outside. Use adverbs within their writing.

Reading Retell and discuss less familiar stories. Record information from a range of non-fiction texts. Answer questions involving inference.
