



# Termly Curriculum Overview

## Autumn Term

### English

- **Stories with familiar setting**-reading and comparing the Funnybones. Writing our own Funnybones stories.
- **Poems on a theme**-reading and comparing poems about the senses. Writing simple poems.
- **Instructions**-reading and comparing sets of instructions. Writing a set of instructions.
- **Information texts**-investigating how information texts are written. Writing a simple explanation text.
- **Story as a theme**-The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark.  
**The children will also do daily phonics and will do a guided read once a week.**

### Science and Creative Curriculum

#### Science

#### History

### Mathematics

- **Number and Place Value**-reading, writing and ordering numbers up to 100 and beyond and understanding the value of each digit. Counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s.
- **Addition and subtraction**-adding and subtracting one and two-digit numbers.
- **Measurement**-money. Recognising and using coins. Making amounts. Addition and subtraction of money.
- **Multiplication and division**-2s, 5s and 10s
- **Problem solving and reasoning**-involving all of the above areas.
