A reminder that it is own clothes day next Friday in exchange for chocolates and sweets for the Summer Fair. Thank you.



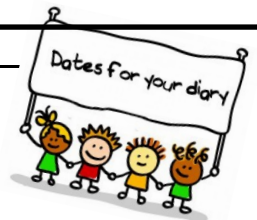
Thank you so much to the governors for buying ice lollies for all the children today. They were VERY much appreciated!!
