WOPPS and Music Lesson Concerts

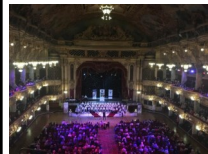
Thank you so much to our very talented Year 5 children for their performance on Monday. They have clearly learned a lot from their year playing woodwind instruments!

Please ensure that your account is up to date before close of school next Friday - particularly if your child is in Year 6. Thank you. (*Cheques payable to L.C.C. please*)



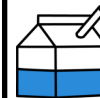
Dinner Money for the first half of the Autumn Term will be £85.80 (4th September to 26th October).
