Postage Stamps



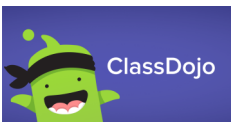

Please use Class Dojo for messages to your child's class teacher.

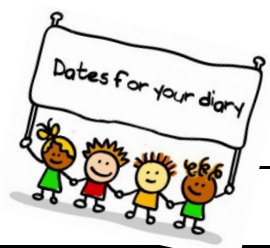


Please ensure that your child brings everything they will require for the school day with them.
