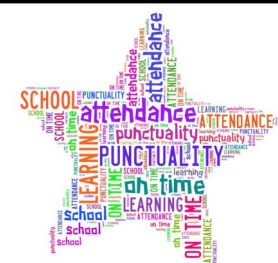
Design a Crib - St. Cuthbert's Church
