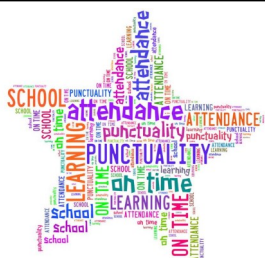


Thank you so much for today's donations of bottles for the PTFA Christmas Fair and thank you to those who attended to
