Woodwind and Brass Lesson Fees

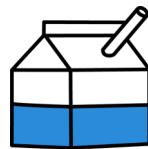


Lesson fees for the 9 lessons in the Spring Term will be £59.40. A reminder that lesson fees are due promptly at the beginning of each term. Thank you.

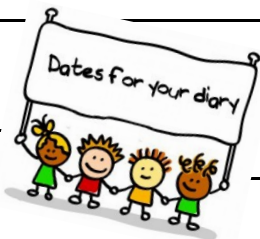

Amelia For being a fantastic role model to others.

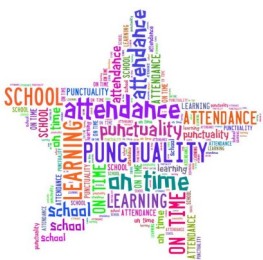
This week we have been learning Roman Numerals and negative numbers.
