### **School Uniform**

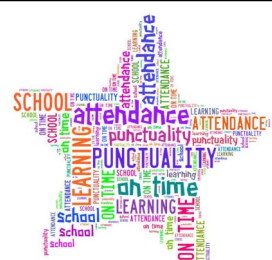
### **Dinner Money (KS2 only)**
