## **School Uniform**

The children should now be wearing their summer uniform:

### **Reception through to Year 4**

Boys: white polo shirt with school logo, grey **school** shorts or long **school** trousers with **black shoes**.

Girls: green and white striped/checked dress, or grey **tailored, knee-length school shorts**, with **black shoes**.

If winter uniform is worn, then children must also wear their ties.

**Y5 and Y6** should continue to wear their blazers with a shirt and tie, grey skirt, grey **school** trousers or grey **knee-length school** shorts, with **black shoes**. All hair accessories must be school colours. Girls may wear summer dresses.

**PE Kit:** green shorts, white round neck T shirt with school logo on and pumps should be in school at all times. Black trainers may be worn for outside P.E. lessons.
