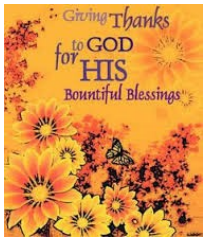

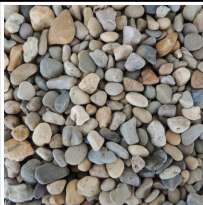
.... in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Jesus Christ for you. 1 Thessalonians 5:18

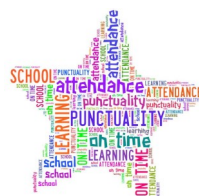
