Dinner Money (KS2 only)

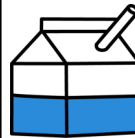
Dinner Money for this half term is £55. May I remind you that dinners are payable in advance please. Cheques to *L.C.C. (Lancashire County Council)*.

Dinner Money - Next Half Term

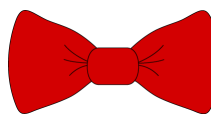
