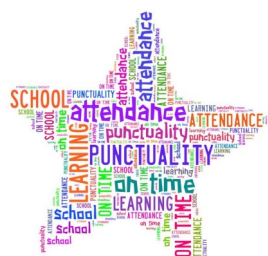
A special thank you to Mr. Reid and Appliance House
