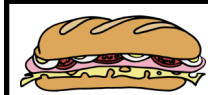

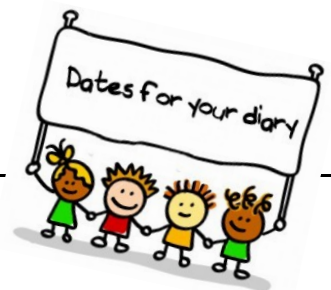
Congratulations to all our Stars of the Week
