

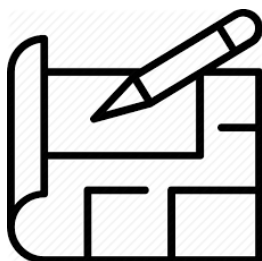


*Show proper respect to everyone .... 1 Peter 2:17*

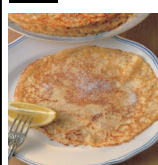
### Year 5 Samba!

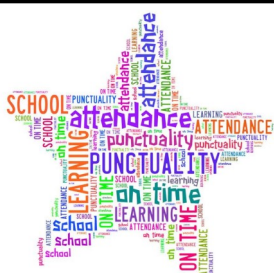
