Babies

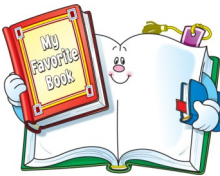

Scholastic Book Fair

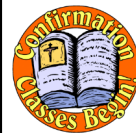


The Book Fair will take place from Wednesday 6th March through to Tuesday 12th March from 3:30pm in the KS2 resource area.

 ★ Rufus For being: helpful, kind, sensible, hard-working and so many other wonderful things!

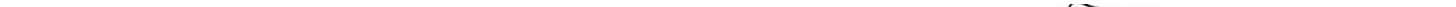
- ★ This week we have been learning all about fractions and we started our new English topic based on Aladdin!

 ★ Dylan For great expression when reading aloud and applying this to his role as Tybalt.

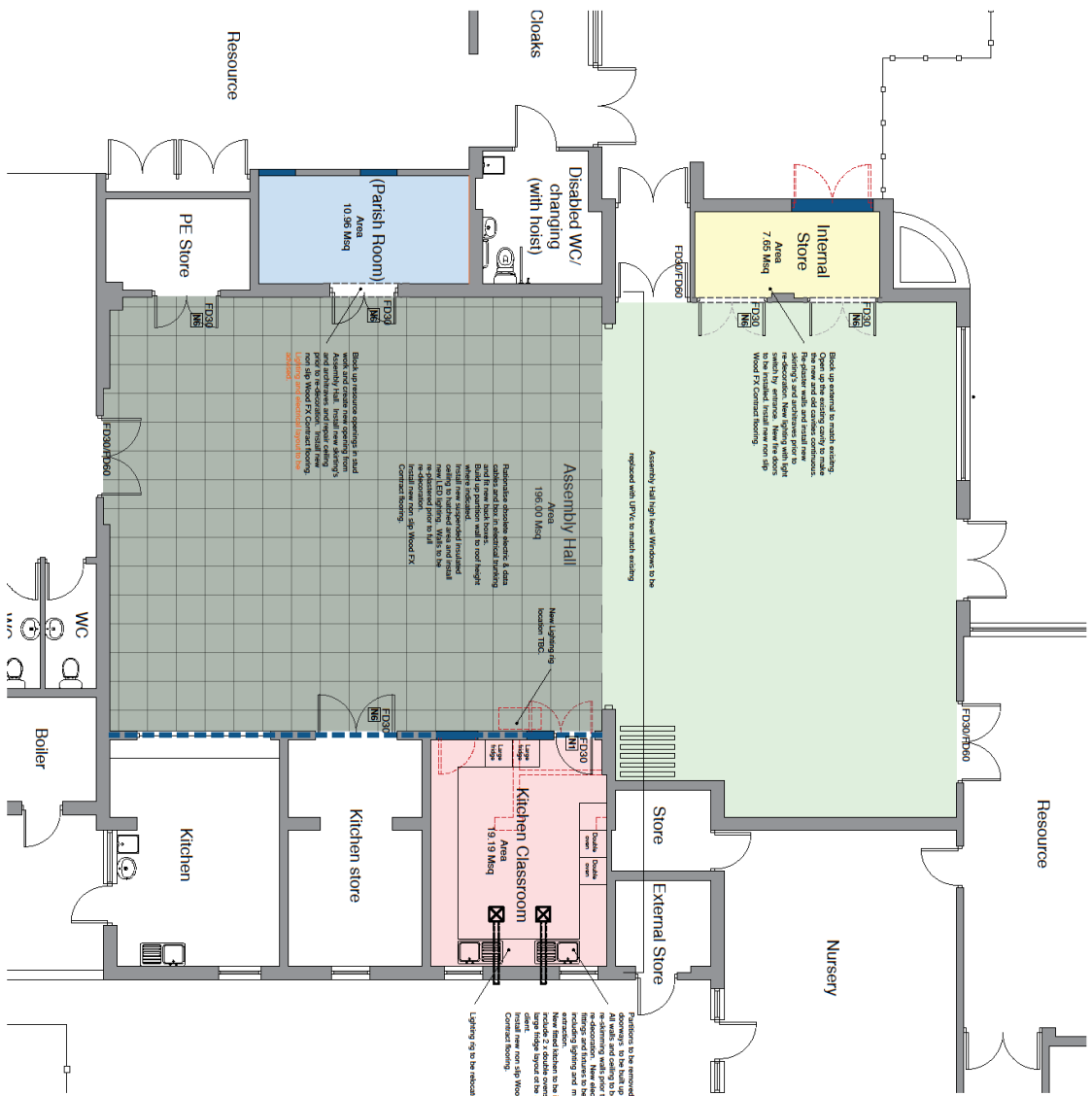
- ★ This week we have started our new topic - Inventions and Inventors.
