Dinner money for this half term (25th February to 10th April) at £2.30 per meal is £75.90.

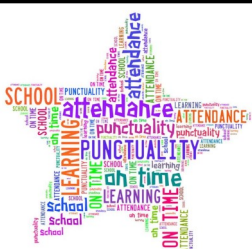
May I remind you that payment is due IN ADVANCE via ParentPay.

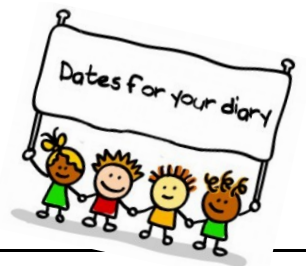
