### School Uniform

**Y5 and Y6** should continue to wear their blazers with a shirt and tie, and skirt, trousers or **knee-length** shorts.

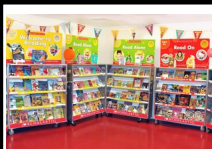
All hair accessories must be school colours.
