We are continuing to collect Aldi stickers. We need a final push to complete the second poster so please keep them coming! Thank you.



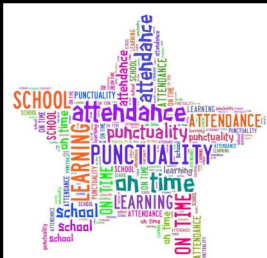
Ad-hoc School Dinners

We try to be as flexible as possible with dinner arrangements, however, may we remind parents to notify the school office the previous day of any changes in their child's meal arrangements, and to pay for meals in advance via ParentPay. This is so we can liaise with the Kitchen Manager to ensure that the correct quantity of food is prepared and to assist in effective administration. This also applies if you wish your child to change from Hot School Meals to Packed Lunches or vice-versa. There have been a number of occasions recently when a hot school meal has been taken on an 'ad hoc' basis, without prior notice to the school office, which has caused difficulty providing the correct number of meals.
