RECOVERY PREMIUM FUNDING

In February 2021, the Government announced a one-off recovery premium as part of its package of funding to support education recovery.

The recovery premium provides additional funding for state-funded schools in the 2021-22 academic year. The funding will help schools deliver evidence-based approaches for supporting disadvantaged pupils.

Pupil Eligibility

The recovery premium is allocated using the same data as pupil premium. This means that the following pupils will attract recovery premium funding to schools:

- Pupils who are eligible for free school meals
- Pupils who have been eligible for free school meals for the last six years at any point
- Children looked after by local authorities and referred to as looked-after children (LAC)
- Post looked-after children (post-LAC)

Funding Allocation

The funding allocation for Lytham CE Primary School is **£3159.00**

This premium will be paid to the school in four payments over the school year.

Using the recovery premium funding

Our school will spend the premium on evidence-based approaches to support pupils, in line with the Education Endowment Foundation's pupil premium guide (<https://educationendowmentfoundation.org.uk/evidence-summaries/pupil-premium-guide>)

Activities will include those that;

- Support the quality of teaching, such as professional development of staff
- Provide academic targeted support, such as tutoring
- Deal with non-academic barriers to learning, such as attendance, behaviour and social and emotional support
