


Snippets from the classrooms

In Nursery this week we have been finding out about different sea creatures as part of our 'Under The Sea' topic. We also joined in with Sports Day and made everyone really proud with how confidently we embraced the experience.

Reception - This week we have been talking all about how special our daddy's are. We have done some amazing independent writing about them. We have also made them a surprise to keep! In our outdoor area we have a new relaxation zone. It is a lovely space to chill out and relax and read. We love reading books in Reception so this new area is going down a treat!

In Year two this week, we have loved exploring the story "The Sea Saw" with Miss Bolton. It links to our new topic based around the seaside. We also had the most amazing time at Sports Day!!

Year three - In Science this week, we have been digging up weeds so that we can look more closely at the roots. We used our magnifying glasses and drew our plants in detail. We learnt that the roots are needed to hold the plants firmly in the soil and soak up water and nutrients from the soil.
