### English

- Writing cursive letters
- Name writing (first name and surname)

- Spelling the days of the week
- Reading and spelling common exception words
- Using capital letters and full stops
- Reading and spelling words containing Phase 2, 3, 4 and 5 sounds
- Use familiar plots for structuring the opening, middle and end of a story.

- Recognise and name 2D and 3D shapes
