### **P.E. - Jewellery**

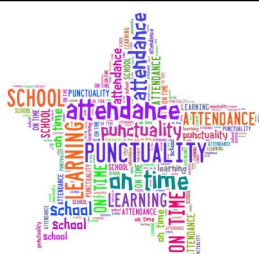
Can I please remind you that all jewellery, including earrings, **MUST** be REMOVED for PE lessons. This is standard Health and Safety policy. Thank you.
