**Y5 and Y6** should continue to wear their blazers with a shirt and tie, grey skirt, grey **school** trousers or grey **knee-length school** shorts.

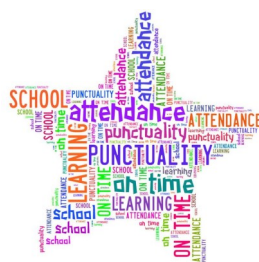
All hair accessories must be school colours.
