Dear Parents / Carers

Re: Year 11 Geography Fieldtrip to Liverpool, 13th December 2024.

On Friday December 13th the Year 11 GCSE Geography students will be undertaking a Geography Fieldtrip to Liverpool. We are currently studying the Urban Issues Module in class and have chosen Liverpool as a Case Study. Although the trip is not compulsory, it will greatly enhance your child's understanding of the changes that have occurred in Liverpool. Pupils will mostly be supervised by their teachers in a large group as we complete the guided tour of Liverpool. There will also be an opportunity for pupils to have some free time during lunch. During this time, for safety purposes, pupils must stay in groups of at least 3. We will have designated meeting point and mobile phone contact throughout this period.

The cost of the trip will be £20.00, which will cover the transport costs to and from Liverpool, to be paid through Parent Pay. We will be leaving school at 8.00am and hope to return as close to 4pm as we can. Pupils must therefore be at school at, or before 7.45am. Appropriate clothing and footwear will be required for the field trip as it will probably be cold, potentially wet, and there will be a considerable amount of walking.

As always, the trip is reserved for Geography students who have maintained an excellent behaviour record in school and can be trusted to behave sensibly on the day. If, for any pupil, behaviour in school should fall below the expected standard, unfortunately, they will not be allowed to attend the trip. If you would like your child to attend the Liverpool trip, please could you pay the £20.00 on Parent Pay and complete the permission slip to Mr Curtis or Mr Walker below by the deadline which is 30th November 2024.
