

Dear Parent/Carer,

As you will be aware, our second set of Year 11 mock examinations have recently concluded. These assessments mark an important milestone for our students as we move into the final phase of preparation for the summer GCSE examinations.

Following the mocks, teachers will now be carefully reviewing students' performance to identify strengths as well as any remaining gaps in knowledge or understanding. This information will allow us to put in place **targeted intervention and additional support** to help every student maximise their potential over the coming weeks.

To support this next stage, **we will continue to offer additional after-school revision sessions**. These sessions are designed to help students consolidate their learning, revisit key areas identified through the mock examinations, and develop effective revision strategies with the support of their subject teachers. Where we feel that an additional after-school revision session will be fundamental for your child to attend in order to secure their target grade, we will be in contact directly to arrange this and formally add it to their timetables.

The coming weeks are vitally important. **Regular attendance at school is essential** so that students can fully benefit from the feedback, targeted teaching and intervention that will follow the mock exams. Missing lessons at this stage can mean missing key opportunities to close gaps in learning ahead of the final GCSE examinations.

Below, you will find a **timetable of the after-school Revision and Booster sessions** being offered, including the subjects and dates available. We would encourage you to take a few moments to review this with your child and support them in attending as many sessions as possible.

Whilst these sessions are not compulsory, they are strongly recommended, as they provide valuable additional preparation and support during this crucial stage of Year 11.

Following on from our **Parent-Support Revision Workshop**, we have also collated topic lists for all subjects so that you can support your child with their revision timetables as feedback from the mocks will now inform their priorities for the final few weeks. Please find this attached.

We have also added a **follow-up Parent Support Revision Workshop** that we would like to invite you to, taking place on **Monday 13<sup>th</sup> April, 5-6pm in the main hall**.

Thank you, as always, for your continued support as we work together to help our students achieve their very best.
