The History department are proposing to take a group of Year 7 students to Warwick Castle on Thursday 15th October 2026. The trip will be a great opportunity to introduce the students to a thousand years of History, specifically on how castles were used to establish control and the effects on the local population. The students will get the opportunity to explore the castle, watch a trebuchet demonstration, falconry show and find their way out of the horrible histories maze!

Pupils will be in school at normal time and shall leave school at approximately 8.50am and return to Madeley at 5pm (approx..). **Parents/ carers must make arrangements to collect your child from school at 5pm.** A fee of **£35** is charged to cover the cost of entrance and transport to and from Warwick Castle. Students will be required to wear suitable clothing/ footwear, a packed lunch and a small amount of spending money should they wish to purchase a souvenir. The attraction is mostly outdoors so warm clothing, and a coat is advised.
