## Dear Parents / Carers

It is with enormous pleasure that I write to share the fantastic news that Madeley has once again been rated 'Good' by Ofsted.

This excellent news follows a two-day Section 8 Ofsted inspection which, as you know, took place on December 3rd and 4th.

I am delighted that Ofsted has recognised all the excellent work going on here at Madeley and as a proud member of the Shaw Education Trust what a 'special place' the school truly is for all pupils. We are delighted with the Ofsted acknowledgment that we are "a school with a huge amount of integrity."

The inspectors noted how we have maintained "the good quality education" and continued to drive improvement across the school, since our last inspection in February 2016.

The report, along with inspectors' verbal feedback, recognised the school's strong relationships between pupils and staff and how we work hard to make students and the wider community feel part of everything we do, with pupils being unanimously positive about the school and wearing their uniforms with pride.

We could not have achieved this without your support, and I would like to take this opportunity to thank all of you, your fantastic children and our dedicated staff for their hard work and commitment which has helped to make Madeley such an amazing place to learn, work and succeed.
