We are excited to announce that our Year 7 pupils will all be part of our 1:1 iPad programme. Each pupil will receive their own iPad 8th Gen to use in school and at home. This development was introduced to the school two years ago; we have seen a positive impact on the teaching, learning and outcomes for our current Year 8 and 9 pupils, and we know that your children will also thrive with this technology.

The iPad digital strategy aims to enhance the quality of teaching and learning at Madeley School and enable pupils to be better prepared to thrive in an ever-changing world. Over the past three years, the school have invested in the infrastructure and capacity necessary to take this step, including updating all Promethean screens across the school and improved WiFi.

It provides Year 7 pupils with the digital resilience to get through whatever challenges learning presents in the future and supports homework tasks. It will also provide access for all pupils learning at home, and will help parents/carers to help their child. Fundamentally, the aim is that your children will be as well prepared to flourish in their studies, and beyond, as possible.
