Key Questions: Who is Henri Rousseau and what is he famous for? What techniques and medium are used? How have materials been used to create texture?	<ul> <li>Henri Rousseau is a French painter from the 1800's.</li> <li>They will be able to explain that abstract art means that it is a version of the object but not exactly as it appears.</li> <li>Children will know how to use lines and different medium to draw plants i* the back ground.</li> <li>Children know that sometimes what you see in art work may not be the actual reality of the objects: size, appearance, colour.</li> <li>Children know what layering is and that it is used to create depth in a piece of work.</li> <li>They know that the background is layered down first, then the middle ground and then the foreground.</li> <li>Children to know that you can create different effects with paper such as scrunching, twisting, layering.</li> <li>To know that observational drawings involve looking directly at something and drawing how you see it.</li> <li>Children can evaluate their final piece using substantive and disciplinary vocabulary.</li> </ul>	Art History:  Name of Artist/DOB+D  Era/ time period of Art (use specific names e.g. renaissance)  Medium  Materials they used  Methods they used  Inspiration  Developing Ideas:  Plan out future work in a sketch book – experimenting with ideas and different media.
