<u>Christmas dinner</u>

This year, Christmas Dinner will be on Thursday 15th December. We also have a vegetarian option, which will be a Quorn fillet. The cost of the dinner is £2.25 for children in Years 3,4,5,6 and Nursery; this will appear on your child's account under dinners on the day via the 'my child at school' app. If your child usually has a school meal, this is to be paid as normal for that week. All children in Reception, Years 1 and 2 are entitled to Universal Free School Meals, so you do not need to pay. Also, if your child is entitled to 'free school meals', you do not need to pay.

How to apply for a Primary Place (Reception Application)

Tameside residents should use the Tameside Citizen Portal to apply for a Reception place. **If you do not live within Tameside but wish to apply for a place at a Tameside school, you should apply via your own Local Authority.** (For example, if you are a Stockport resident you will need to apply via Stockport MBC admissions, for any Tameside School)

The closing date for submitting a **Reception 2023 school application is** <u>**15 January**</u> <u>**2023**</u>. (Applications submitted after this date will be processed as a 'late' application)

When will you be informed of your allocated school?

- <u>On-time applications</u> if your application was submitted **on or before** the closing date, **15 January 2023**, you will be notified of your allocated school, by email, at some point during **National Offer Day 17 April 2023**. You will also be able to view your allocated school by logging into your Citizen Portal after midnight on National Offer Day.
- <u>Late applications</u> if your application was submitted after the closing date, 15
 January 2023, you will receive notification of your allocated school at a later date, by letter. Late allocations are not viewable via the Citizen's Portal.

01 November 2022	The online admissions system opens for primary school places (Reception 2023).
15 January 2023	Closing date for applications. Ensure you submit your primary school application on or before this date. Otherwise, you will need to make a late application.
30 January 2023	The online admissions system opens for 'late' primary school applications (Reception 2023).
03 February 2023	Last date for any changes to the address in your application.
17 April 2023	National Offer Day.
