PE KITS

Children also need either a pair of pumps or trainers.

All children who do not have the correct PE kit will have a text sent home next week to inform parents that this is the case. Letters will also be sent home to reinforce this.

It is then expected that after the holiday all children will have the correct PE kit and will bring it to school for both of their PE sessions. Children who have the correct PE kit will be given a gold card each session.

PE kits should be brought to school for the full half term, and taken home for washing during the holiday.
