Activity:

Dolls house/ Farm yard

Join in with your child when they are playing with their dolls house or farm yard

Follow your child's lead and ask questions including "who?"

Example: Place an animal/ doll in a sleeping position and ask your child "who is sleeping?"

Activity:

Hide and Seek

Take it in turns to play hide and seek with your child's favourite toy

Hide their toy in the house and ask your child "where can it be?"

Give choices: "Is it in the cupboard or under the bed?" encouraging your child to use their language

Activity:

Give a choice: "is he sleeping or sitting on the chair?"

Topic: Describe characteristics

Activity:

Find me

Use a bag filled with objects/ toys

Take it in turns to ask the other person to choose something out of the bag from description E.g. find me something that is soft

Once an item has been chosen, ask your child to tell you more about the item

Prompt your child to use descriptive language E.g. shape, size, colour, function
