Dear families

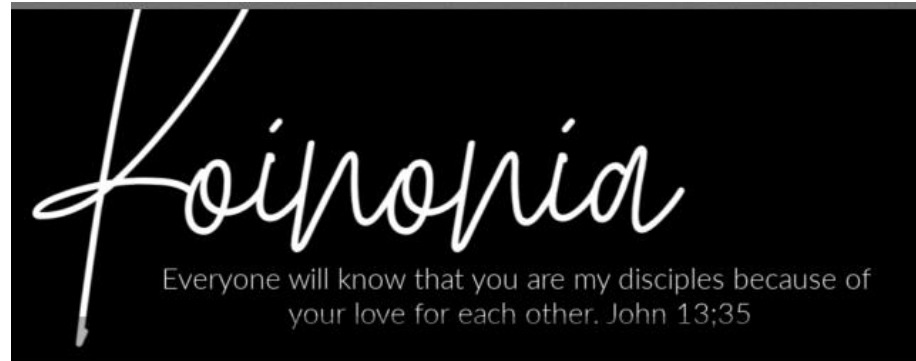
