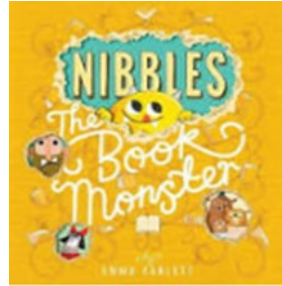


Science

Geography

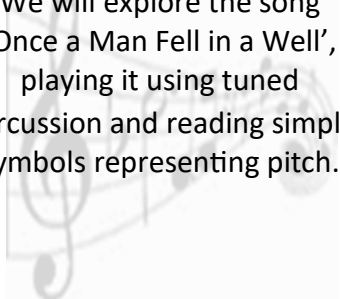
Would you prefer to live in a hot or cold place? Revisiting continents and oceans, we will investigate places around the world with contrasting temperatures.



Summer Term 2 Curriculum – Class 1

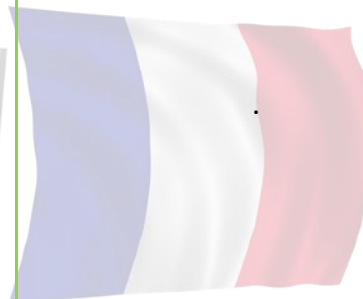
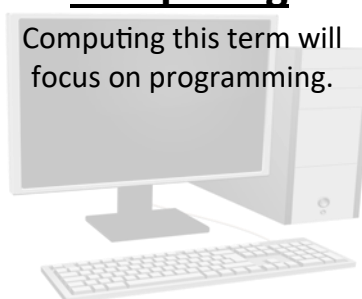
Music

We will explore the song 'Once a Man Fell in a Well', playing it using tuned percussion and reading simple symbols representing pitch.



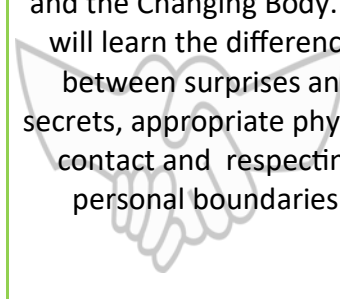
Computing
