

## TOPIC

In geography, Oak will seek to answer the question: 'what is life like in the alps?' We will use a variety of data collection methods including questionnaires, mapping routes and recording findings in sketches or photographs.

## ART/DT

Oak will be exploring drawing this term, with the unit title named 'I need space'.

## COMPUTING

In computing, the children will be creating media video-production to create a short film.

## PSHE

Our PSHE topic for this term focuses on health and well being. We will explore why a good night's sleep is important, why we should embrace failure and form a strategy to help us manage feelings of failure to help us to persevere.

## ENGLISH

For our narrative this term, we are exploring extracts from Secret Garden by Frances Hodgson Burnett. Making cross-curricular links to topic, our non-narrative focuses on information texts by the National Geographic. We will finish with our poetry unit, exploring Cloud Busting by Malorie Blackman.

## MATHS

Following the completion of multiplication and division, Oak will deepen their understanding of fractions with two units . By the end of the term, the children will be exploring converting units.

## RE

In RE, Oak will explore Incarnation within the Big Frieze to ultimately answer the question: 'was Jesus a Messiah?'

## SCIENCE

In science, we are exploring forces, specifically space and Earth. We will learn about geocentric and heliocentric models, name and describe the shape of celestial bodies including their orbits and forces. We will also explain how seasons, day and night occur and how a sundial works.
