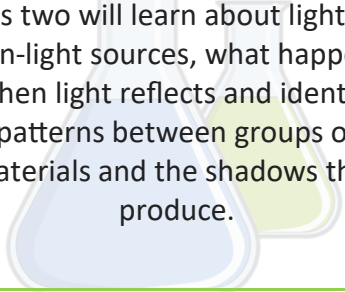


Science

By exploring light and shadows, class two will learn about light and non-light sources, what happens when light reflects and identify patterns between groups of materials and the shadows they produce.

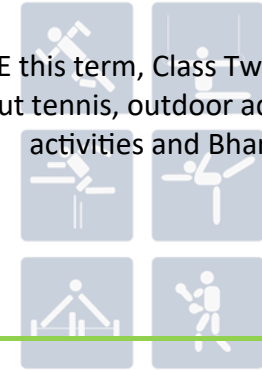


English

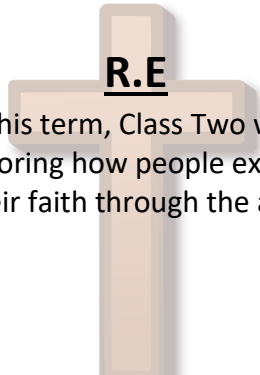
P.E

For this term, Class Two will be exploring how people express their faith through the arts.



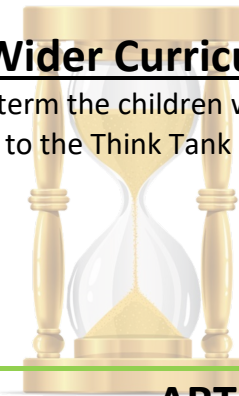
Maths

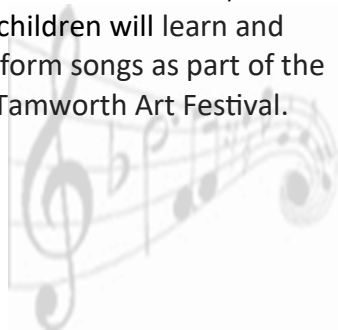
This term the children will enjoy a trip to the Think Tank museum!



Summer Term One Curriculum – Class Two

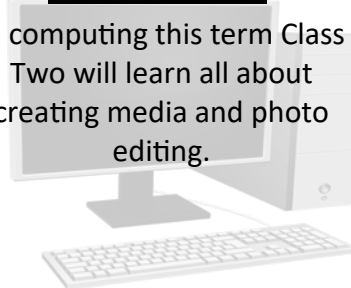
Music

In computing this term Class Two will learn all about creating media and photo editing.



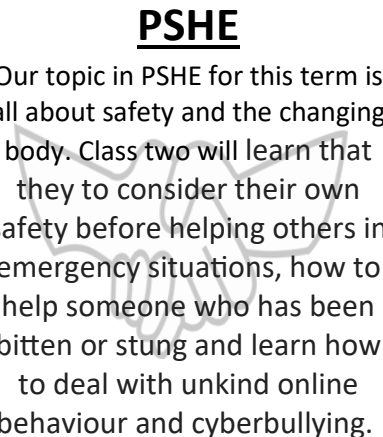
French
