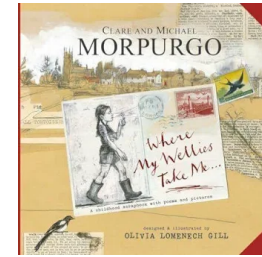
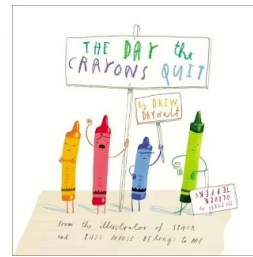


Science

Our topic is all about Microhabitats. We will identify and classify a variety of minibeasts. We will describe microhabitats and their conditions. We will plan and carry out an experiment. We will identify a variety of flowering plants and describe the role of a botanist.



English

We will retell the story of Supertato from the perspective of the Evil Pea. We will write a letter to Duncan as a crayon character to tell him what adventures they had been on since they quit! Finally, we will create and perform a poem inspired by a countryside walk in a pair of wellies.

P.E

Our PE lessons will focus on fundamentals and Yoga. Fundamentals lessons will focus on the basic skills such as agility, balance, and coordination that children need in order to participate in competitive sports. Yoga will support their development of flexibility, strength and mindfulness.

R.E

The question we will answer is "What do Muslims believe?" Children will understand what Islam is, where it began and who follows it. They will learn that the Arabic word for God is Allah, and that Muslims believe that there is no god but Allah.

Maths

Year 1 will begin the half term focusing on Place Value (within 20). After this we will move onto Addition and Subtraction (within 20).

Year 2 will begin the half term focusing on Money before moving onto Multiplication and Division.

History

What is a monarch?

We will describe what a monarch is and explain why coronations take place. We will use sources to explain how William the Conqueror became King of England. We will identify the two types of castles built by the Normans and sequence castles on a timeline.

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Music

Our theme is Musical Me. We will explore the song 'Once a Man Fell in a Well', play it using tuned percussion and read simple symbols representing pitch.

Computing

Our topic is Programming Algorithms. We will understand what an algorithm is. We will follow an algorithm and explore what inputs and outputs are. We will identify bugs in an algorithm and how to fix them.



PSHE

Our theme is Citizenship. We will understand the importance of rules. We will recognise ways in which we are similar and different to other people. We will explore the roles people have in our community and understand how we can look after the environment.

D&T

Our topic is all about textiles. We will explore how to join fabrics together using different methods. We will design a puppet based on a storybook character and we will embellish our puppet creations to match our original design.
