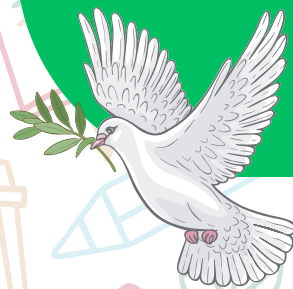
MATHS

SCIENCE
