

Learning Challenge : how can I create an oversized animal collage?

Gather all kind of papers: newspaper, magazines, wallpaper, scrap paper, old books, wrapping paper, old music manuscripts, coloured plastic wrapping... - you can even create your own paper: use markers, pastels, watercolour, gouache...



STEP 1:

Cut out long strips of paper (triangle shapes and rectangular shapes) - glue them STIP 2. Cut out long strips of paper (triangle snapes and rectangular snapes) - give memory on an A3 card, pointing towards the middle of the page – overlap the strips and let them go over the edges of the card in an irregular way – alternate colours and designs





















STEP 3. Choose an animal and sketch large eyes/mouth/noose/beak on an A3 card





A DOG...








A CAT...
















STEP 4:

- Colour the noose and the eyes with markers/oil pastels/black ink : darker colour on the outside of the iris, lighter in the centre – white shine in the pupil
- Then cut them off and glue them on your collage





STLP 5. Glue the eyes and the noose/mouth/beak with a glue stick Use acrylic grey/white/black paint to paint around the eyes

 Use acrylic grey/white/black paint to paint around the eyes and the mouth – use a fine brush to paint the hair and the whiskers (if a cat)
