

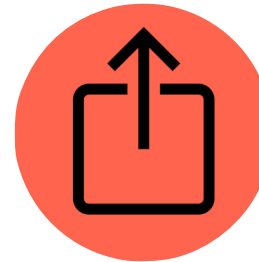
Maryport Church of England School Book Spine

At Maryport Church of England Primary School, we put reading at the highest priority. Reading takes place every day in different ways - listening to class stories, analysing and answering comprehension questions, sharing books with others, focusing on a book for writing, reading out loud, performing poetry. Over the year each class are exposed to many authors, genres, text types, poems and inspiring people. Each class book spine gives an overview of the books and texts covered over each half term.



Class story book

This book is read out loud daily to the class. Children answer retrieval, summary and prediction questions based around it on two days over the week.



Books to share

Elements of these books are shared with the class often to help curriculum understanding.



Story used to inspire writing

This book is used as an anchor for the writing curriculum.



Texts to analyse

These books and texts are used within reading comprehension lessons. Questions from the VIPERS strands are used to question children on what they have read.
