

# Maryport Church of England Primary School 'Learn, achieve, shine'

## <u>Uniform</u>

Our uniform consists of – Grey trousers/shorts, skirts, pinafores – with the option of the blue-grey checked skirts/pinafores Optional blue checked dresses in summer White polo shirt Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan Black shoes (no logos) – this has been relaxed for the summer term but will be required again for September. No open toed sandals please. PE – white T shirt, black shorts or joggers and optional sky blue hoody.

We are also introducing uniform to our 2 year old provision.

In September we will be continuing with asking the children to come in wearing their PE kits on PE days as we have found this gives more time being active, less fuss and certainly less lost clothing! As we, hopefully, move into the warmer, sunnier weather please make sure your child has a sun hat or cap to wear outdoors.
